



Use the [QPP Participation Status Tool](#) in **December 2025** to confirm whether your practice is eligible for MIPS and a potential payment adjustment.

Your **preliminary eligibility** is now available, and your **final eligibility** will be posted in **December 2025**. Checking this early ensures you can plan your reporting and avoid surprises later.
