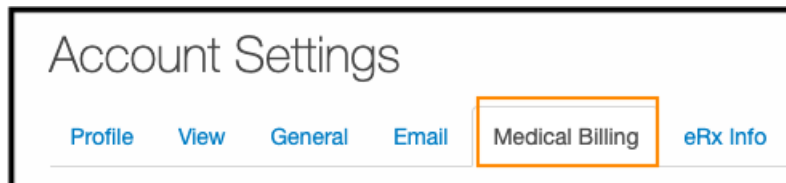
Using DSM-5 Codes

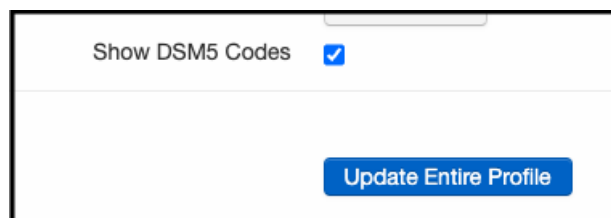

Turning on DSM-5 codes

1. Navigate to **Account > Provider Settings**
2. Select the **Medical Billing** tab




3. Scroll down to the Miscellaneous section
