

Incorrect default prescriber address	We have resolved an issue while sending prescriptions in which the the most recently added location for the account.
Task updates removing patient name	We have fixed an issue that was impacting some users that caused t removed when a task was updated to complete.

Unable to dismiss keyboard	We have resolved an issue where the keyboard could not be dismissed for some patients. You can now tap anywhere on the screen to dismiss the keyboard.
App crashes when sending out eRx	We have resolved an issue impacting some users who reported the app crashing when sending out a prescription. Note: Please update your device to the latest version iOS 17 to ensure this issue is resolved.
The library button is no longer blocked on iPhone 14 when adding an image to a free draw field	We resolved an issue with iPhone 14 front-facing camera lens blocking the library button when adding an image to a free draw field. Note: Please update your device to the latest version iOS 17 to ensure this issue is resolved.
Incorrect Default Prescriber Address	We have fixed an issue while sending prescriptions in which the default address was not the most recently added location for the account.
Patient Flag Name Cut Off	We have fixed a display problem where longer flag names were cut off.
Appointment List Update	We have resolved an issue in which the appointment list was not updated when a new appointment was added.
Incorrect Medication Dosage	We have corrected an issue related to medication dosage changes not being reflected in the clinical note.
