

# GHB Controls on the iPad

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This feature is currently only available to select pilot program users. It will be available for all users in the coming weeks.

As part of DrChrono's DEA audit process, when prescribing a drug containing Gamma Hydroxbutric Acid (GHB), the **Notes to Pharmacy** field is required.
