What to do if your video was previously disabled in your browser

If your camera had been previously disabled in your browser, click on **Safari in** the top left of Safari's toolbar and select **Preferences**.



For Video

Click on **Websites** on the top and then **Camera** on the left. Next, select **Allow** from the dropdown on the left next to the website.



For Sound

Click on **Websites** on the top and then **Microphone** on the left. Next, select **Allow** from the dropdown on the left next to the website.
