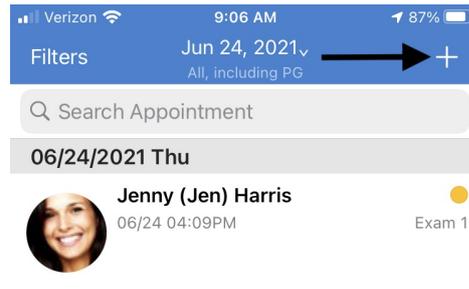
The DrChrono EHR app makes it easy to create appointments through your iPhone for existing patients and new patients.

Create an appointment for an existing patient:

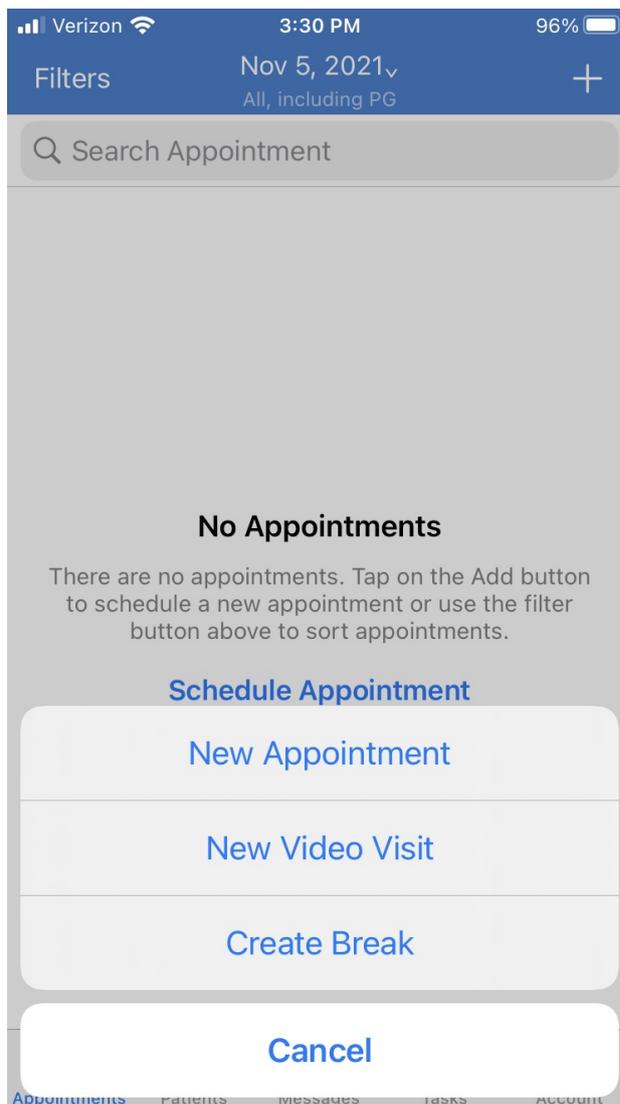
1. After logging in to the app, tap the (



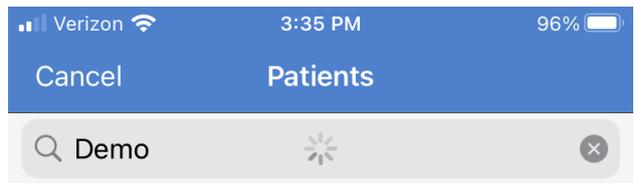
) icon.



2. Select **New Appointment** or **New Video Visit**.



3. Search for the patient you need for the appointment.

Create an appointment for a new patient:

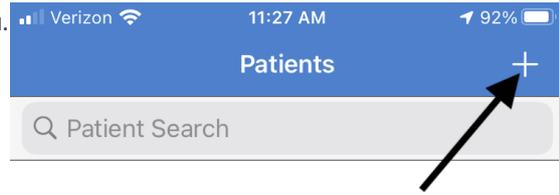
If you need to add an appointment for a new patient, you will first need to add the patient to your EHR account.

) icon to add a new patient.



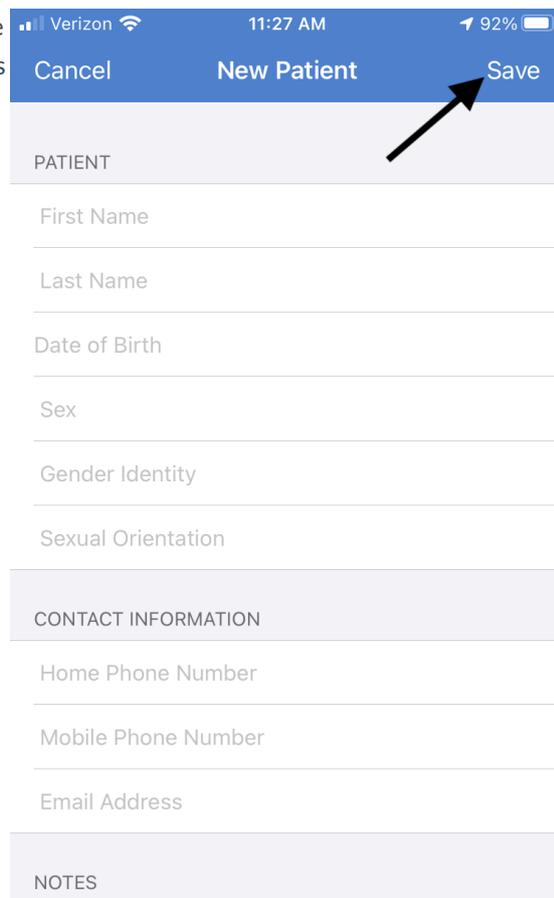
Select a Patient
