


Is There a Dictionary to Search for CPT, HCPCS, and ICD-10 codes?

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All of the billing codes (CPT/HCPCS/ICD-10) and custom codes are searchable in DrChrono. You can easily search these codes by following the steps outlined below:

1. Hover over **Billing** and select **Code Search**.
2. The Code Search screen will allow you to search by ICD-10, HCPCS, Dental, CPT, or Custom Codes you have entered into your account.

3. The system will also allow you to enter a new code that is not in the system by pressing on the green + **New**, over on the right. We upload the newly revised lists each year and add the ad-hoc codes that come up off-cycle when situations warrant (i.e. COVID-19), so it is unlikely that there will be a CPT, ICD-10, or HCPCS code that is not already in the system.
