


Adding Billing Profiles in the Clinical Note

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Utilizing billing profiles allows you to efficiently add ICD-10, CPT, HCPCS, and/or Custom codes to common visit types. Here is how you can add them from the Clinical Note.

1. Navigate to a clinical note and go to the **Billing** tab
