
Creating Codes

Should you need to bill a CPT/HCPCS/ICD-10 that is not available in DrChrono, you can add it manually.


- For CPT codes, you will need the code and its associated long, medium, and short descriptors.
- For **HCPCS** codes, you will need the code and its associated long, and short descriptors.
- For ICD-10 codes, you will need the code and its name.

Once you have those pieces of information, you can add them by following the steps below:


- 1. Hover over **Billing** and select **Code Search** from the right column.
- 2. Click on the green +New button on the right side of the screen.



3. Select +New CPT/+ New HCPCS/+New ICD from the drop-down.



4. Enter the required information and click **Save**.



5. Make sure you add the code to your fee schedule with the appropriate list price. That will ensure that there will be an associated charge when it is entered into a patient's appointment.
