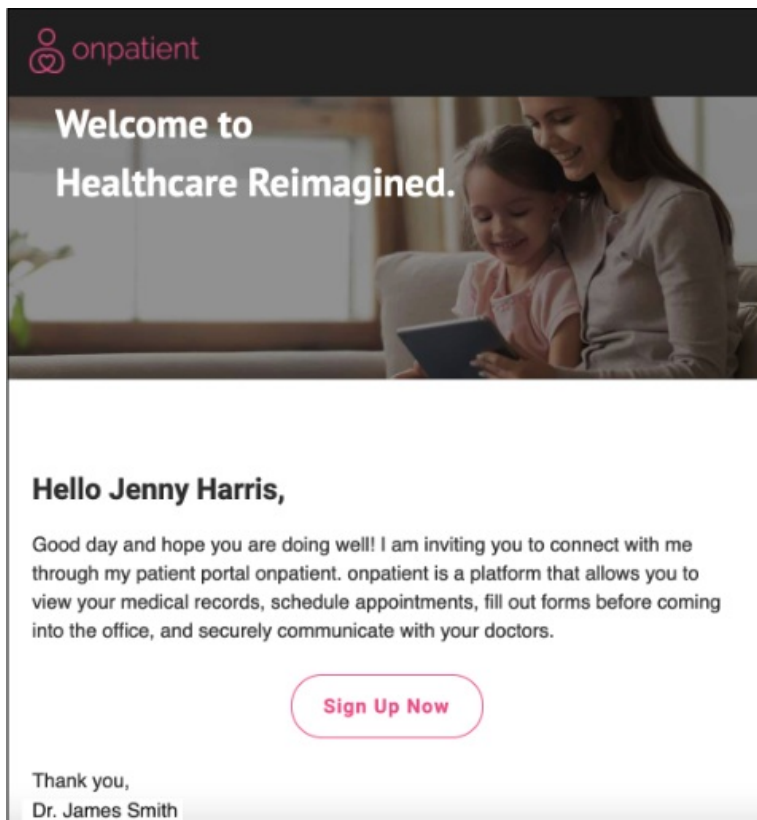


Connect to Your OnPatient Account with Different Providers

If you have an OnPatient account with one provider, you can connect it to a different provider's office.

1. In the invitation email, select **Sign Up Now**.
