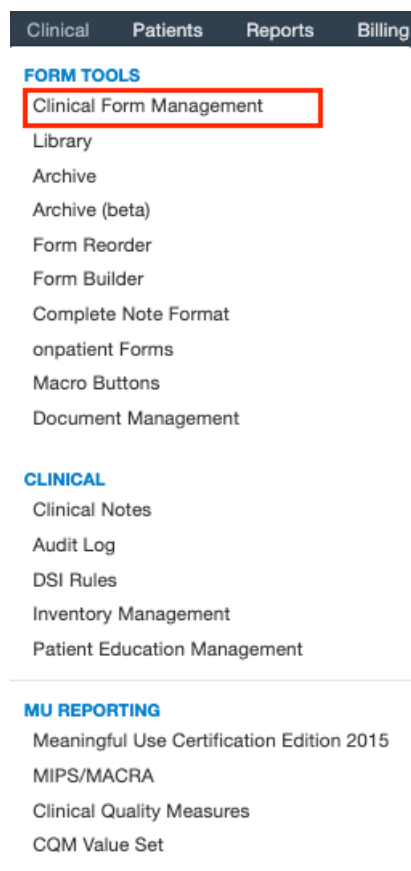

You can customize your own forms for patients to fill out through OnPatient or the Check-In App through the Form Builder in DrChrono.

Building templates for OnPatient follows the same process as building a clinical form by using the same field types and form tools. The forms can be built into the **OnPatient Additional Info** and/or **OnPatient Reasons for Visit** forms. You can also build a template under the **Additional** tab and [set it as a workflow form](#) under **OnPatient Additional Info** and/or **OnPatient Reasons for Visit**.

Before building your form, we recommend reviewing [Best Practices for Building Custom Forms](#) designed to help you make the most of the clinical notes feature.

1. Go to **Clinical > Form Tools > Clinical Form Management**.



2. Search **OnPatient Additional Info** or **OnPatient Reasons for Visit**.
