Here's how:

1. Navigate to the patient's chart and locate the declined estimate.

2. Select the 3 horizontal dots on the right and select Duplicate.



3. The system will give you a pop-up asking if you want to duplicate the estimate.

4. When you press on **OK**, the system will duplicate the estimate and place it in the patient's listing, placing the new/duplicated estimate on top.
