

How are my claim submissions charged to my account?

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DrChrono will not charge for any electronic claim submission to an EDI Medical Payer that goes through eProvider Solutions (ePS).

- If you use the payer ID that starts with PRNT/EPRNT/GPRNT/HRNT, those will be sent on paper instead of electronically and will be charged.
 - If the claim is going to a medical payer through eProvider Solutions (ePS), the charge is \$0.78 per claim.
 - If the claim is an auto accident or workers' compensation claim submitted through Carisk Partners (fka iHCFA), the charge is \$1.50 per claim.
 - If you want to avoid the additional charges, you can always print the HCFA/UB04 and submit it to the payer outside of DrChrono. You can find details on how to print claim forms [here](#).
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
