Search by area codes	You can search for pharmacies using their phone numbers with specific area codes and by including parentheses in the pharmacy name. With the addition of parentheses, you can also search for pharmacies by phone numbers in the 0AAXXXXXXX format and the (0AA)NXX-XXXX format.	
Mobile compound Rx: New no controlled substance toggle switch	When you create a compound prescription using the iPad or iPhone app, a new toggle switch appears allowing you to confirm that there are no controlled substances within the compound prescription. If you attempt to preview the prescription without turning on the toggle switch, an error message appears, indicating that the compound prescription cannot be sent without this confirmation. Mobile support for compound parts in Rx favorite	You can now save a favorite prescription for a compound medication on your mobile device, including the selected compound parts.
