The patient summary view provides both providers and ancillary medical staff with a brief overview of the patient before their visit. This feature facilitates quick access to essential information, streamlining the preparation process and enhancing the quality of care delivered during the patient's appointment.

## The summary screen consists of four widgets, each serving a specific purpose:

- Medications - displays a list of the patient's active medications.
- Allergies - displays a list of the patient's active allergies.
- Problems - displays a list of the patient's active problem list.
- Locked Clinical Notes- displays a list of the patient's most recent locked clinical notes.



- "Go to medication list" hyperlink that navigates to the medication list section of the patient chart.


## Allergies Widget

- Ability to expand or collapse widget, using the icon  in the upper right corner.
- "Go to documents" hyperlink that navigates to the locked clinical notes tab in the document section of the patient chart.
