

# How to Connect Patient Dynamic FHIR API to OnPatient

DrChrono has enhanced OnPatient to enable you to connect seamlessly with third-party apps directly from your OnPatient portal account.

## Steps to activate




To connect to OnPatient, an existing active DHIT account is necessary.

1. Practice initiates an [onpatient invite](#) to the patient.

Patient steps...

2. Follow the invitation instructions to set up your [OnPatient](#) account.
3. On the signup screen, there will be a field for entering the Activation Code. You can find the activation code in the OnPatient invitation.
4. Once logged into the OnPatient account, click on your name (top right corner) to access the settings
5. Click start connection in the "connect a third-party app to your FHIR R4 API" box.



6. Click "activate your FHIR API" under the activation link.
