Active and inactive allergies Add an allergy

The **Allergy List** is streamlined to exclude unnecessary codes with an improved **Add Allergy** feature. The system prevents users from adding non-drug allergies when medication allergies are already listed and blocks entry of duplicate allergies.

Active and inactive allergies

- Allergies are organized by type and severity.
- Drug allergies are prioritized and appear at the top of the list, followed by non-drug allergies.
- The system performs a secondary sort within each category based on severity, ensuring that severe drug allergies are always listed first.
- The number of allergies appears on the Active and Inactive tabs.
- The number of active allergies appears on the Allergy List tab in the patient chart sidebar.

1. Select the Allergy List tab in the patient chart sidebar.

- 2. Select the allergy type.
- 3. Do one of the following:
 - For a specific drug allergy or a drug class allergy, search and select the allergy.
 - For a non-drug allergy, enter the allergy description.
- 4. Select the status.
- 5. (Optional) Select the reaction, severity, or notes.

6. Select Save & Add Another or Add Allergy.
