## Enhancements

### Discontinued iOS 15 support for DrChrono EHR app

Support for iOS 15 has been discontinued in the EHR app to prioritize the development of new versions and enhancements.

### Updated Account Settings

The practice chat and break the glass options have been moved to **Account Settings**.

### 2FA update

When you receive two-factor authentication (2FA) codes via SMS, the iOS keyboard automatically shows the code in the suggestion bar for easy and seamless entry.

### Updated iPad and iPhone login page design

The iPad and iPhone login page designs have been aligned for consistency.

## Resolutions

### Macros improvement

We fixed an issue to ensure that when you select a macro, the field correctly updates with the value when populating the generated text.

### Drug category improvement for iPad EHR app

We fixed an issue to ensure that when you select filters for the Drug Category, the categories populate correctly instead of the Drug ID (number).

### View messages and tasks in split-screen mode

We fixed an issue to enable users to view messages and tasks on iPhone and iPad in split-screen mode.

### Loading history document images

We fixed an issue to ensure users can view history document images.

### Loading insurance photos

We fixed an issue to ensure insurance photos load properly.

## **iPad EHR new version alert**

We fixed an issue to address the delay in notifying users about the availability of new versions of the iPad EHR app.

## **Tasks center filter option**

You are now able to view the filter option within the tasks center.

## **Attachment loading error**

We fixed an issue where you received a failed to load attachment error when viewing a message with an attachment.

## **Saving faxed documents**

We fixed an issue to enable users to save a faxed document to a patient's chart.

## **Updated signed documents**

We fixed an issue to prevent the app from crashing when you signed a document.
