Summary	Description
iOS 15 Support for EHR app discontinued	Support for iOS 15 has been discontinued in the EHR application to prioritize development of new versions and enhancements.
Account settings update	The practice chat and break the glass options have been moved to the Account Settings section.
2FA Update	When users receive 2FA (two-factor authentication) codes via SMS, the iOS keyboard will automatically display the code in the suggestion bar for easy and seamless entry.
iPad and iPhone login page design aligned	The iPad and iPhone login page designs have been aligned for consistency.

Resolutions

Summary	Description
Macros fix	A fix has been implemented to ensure that when selecting a macro, the field correctly updates with the value when populating the generated text.
Drug category fix for iPad EHR app	A fix has been implemented to ensure that when filters for the Drug Category are selected, the categories populate correctly instead of the Drug ID (number).
Viewing messages and tasks	A fix has been implemented to enable users to view messages and tasks on iPhone and iPad in split-screen mode.
Loading history document images	A fix has been implemented to ensure users can view history document images within the EHR app.
Loading insurance photos	A fix has been implemented to ensure insurance photos load properly within the EHR app.
iPad EHR new version alert	A fix has been implemented to address the delay in notifying users about the availability of new versions for the iPad EHR app.
Tasks center filter option	Users are now able to view and the filter option within the tasks center.
Attachment loading error	A fix has been implemented where users were receiving a "fail to load attachment" error when viewing a message with an attachment.
Saving faxed documents	A fix has been implemented to enable users to save a faxed document to a patient's chart.
Signed documents fix	A fix has been implemented to prevent the app from crashing a when document is signed.
