
## **Why This Update Matters**

Snomed CT code field	<ul> <li>provide a unique numerical identifier for each specific allergen or allergic reaction</li> <li>located in patient allergy list under the allergy snomed code column</li> </ul>
Reaction field	<ul> <li>The reaction field records the specific symptoms or adverse effects the patient experiences when exposed to the allergen</li> </ul>
