### Tips and Best Practices

- **Obtain patient consent:** Always inform patients that the conversation is being recorded for documentation purposes
- **Add visit context:** Taking a few seconds to type or dictate the chief complaint improves note accuracy
- **Review before sending:** Always review the generated note for accuracy and completeness before sending to DrChrono
- **Provide feedback:** Use the feedback features to help the AI learn your preferences and improve over time
- **Check microphone settings:** Ensure your microphone is positioned properly and test audio levels before starting
- **Use quiet environments:** Minimize background noise for the best transcription quality
